

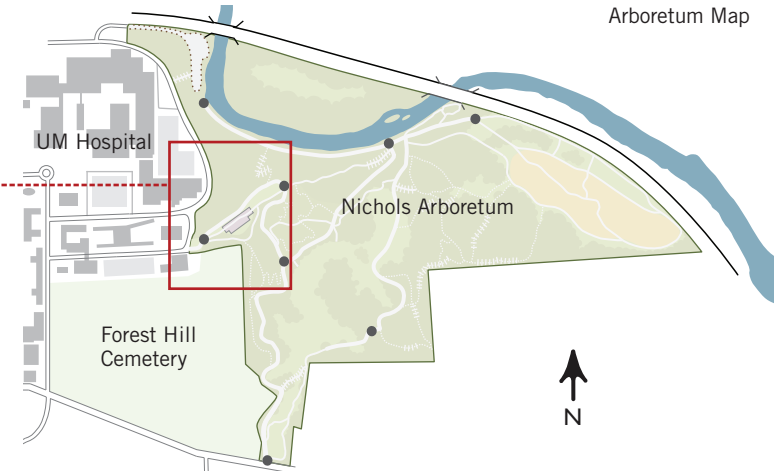
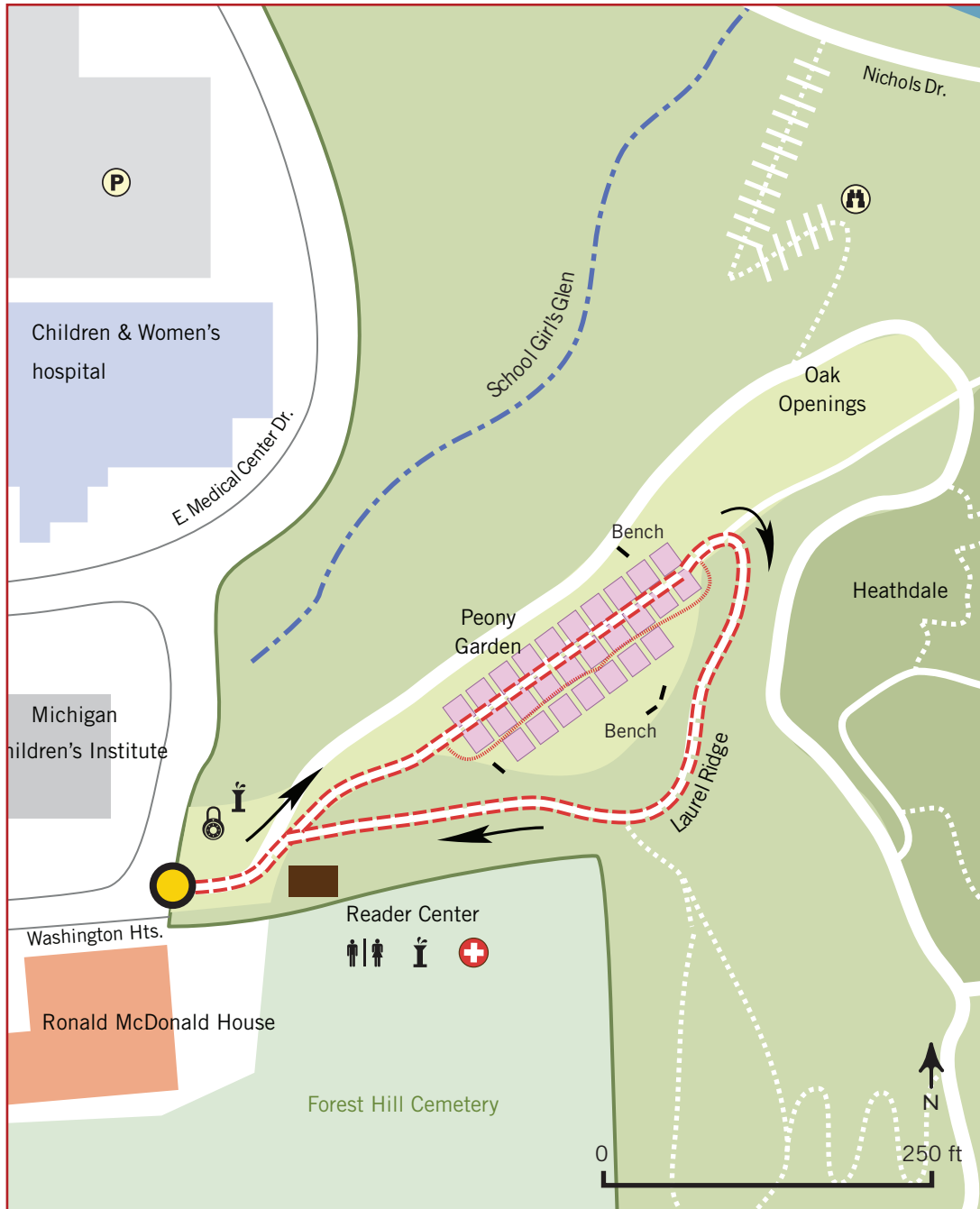

## Trail 1: Peony Trail • Easy



### Peony Trail Overview

The Peony Trail runs flat and straight through a landscaped garden, curving back along a scenic hillside ridge with slight incline. Bloom times along this route - Early to mid-May for Rhodendrons on the Laurel Ridge trail, late May to early June for Peony Garden. The peony garden portion of the trail is wheelchair accessible on wood chip and grass paths.
